- Each Restricted Stock Unit is the equivalent of one share of Forrester Research, Inc. common stock.
- On August 1, 2017, the reporting person was granted 2,644 Restricted Stock Units that vest and convert into common stock in four equal and consecutive installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date.
- On August 1, 2018, the reporting person was granted 2,342 Restricted Stock Units that vest and convert into common stock in four equal and consecutive installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date.
- On August 1, 2019, the reporting person was granted 8,844 Restricted Stock Units that vest and convert into common stock in four equal and consecutive installments beginning on the first anniversary of the grant date.
- On August 3, 2020, the reporting person was granted 9,724 Restricted Stock Units that vest and convert into common stock in four equal installments on August 1, 2021, August 1, 2022, August 1, 2023 and August 1, 2024.
